LEGALIZATION OF MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE

Upon arrival to Serbia you are required to register at local registrar office in local municipality in order to have valid marriage in Serbia and the required documents are:

- 1. Application for registration of free-form (if you request is not submitted in person it is necessary that the person making the request has a valid authorization granted by the holder of a marriage concluded). The request is submitted to the city municipality of the last place of residence of the spouses during the marriage. If spouses did not have a common residence, registration is done at the place of residence of one of the spouses.
- 2. Foreign Marriage Certificate, which must be issued in the international form and legalized*
- 3. Birth Certificate for bride and groom
- 4. Proof of Citizenship for the groom and bride
- 5. Valid identity card or passport for the groom and the bride (photocopy)
- 6. If necessary, other documents
- 7. In the case where one of the spouses is a foreign citizen, appropriate documents for the spouse which is citizen of the Republic of Serbia should be presented and a photocopy of the passport of a foreign citizen
- 8. All foreign documents that are not multilingual forms (international) must be translated by a certified translator on Serbian language.
- * The manner of legalization of Marriage certificate obtained in Jamaica is to send it to the Embassy of Jamaica in Berlin with the fee of 20 euro.
